




Questionnaires can be accessed online or offline on laptops, smart phones and tablet computers; and in different languages




Viewpoint is essentially a communication medium.




My Self Assessment: children's services can make available or 'nudge' young people, parents and carers to access and complete their self assessment or screening tool ...



Viewpoint online graphical reporting: in work with individual young people and their families

These <u>'Child's Journey' reports</u> were originally designed by and for IROs and conference chairs though now being used by practitioners in any service encouraging and supporting young people and families to directly participate in assessment, review and planning processes.



... as the young person completes their self assessment or user feedback questionnaire, their responses are saved straight away enabling their worker to generate distance travelled or child's journey reports
