

Viewpoint is a communication tool to help children and young people share their views, wishes and feelings. Practitioners working with children and young people have a key role in ensuring that they are supported and encouraged to use Viewpoint and in following up responses to inform ongoing individual work and planning.

Different styles are available

- With graphics
- Without graphics

Questionnaires can be accessed Online using a laptop, tablet or phone



Viewing responses

Once a questionnaire has been completed, the responses are displayed on the screen. A practitioner can also login with the young person's details and select report

Following the completion of a questionnaire it is important for the practitioner to talk with the young person about their responses: to check that they are 'safe and settled', to identify what is working well and what issues need to be addressed in ongoing work and plans.
